1 SEC. 2975. (1) THE OWNER OF A DOMESTIC COMPANION ANIMAL MAY 2 BRING A CIVIL ACTION AND RECOVER NONECONOMIC DAMAGES UP TO 3 \$250,000.00 FOR LOSS OF THAT DOMESTIC COMPANION ANIMAL CAUSED BY 4 ANOTHER PERSON'S GROSS NEGLIGENCE OR WILLFUL AND WANTON 5 MISCONDUCT.
