Analysis **Summary**
This bill would limit the application fee paid by a nonprofit organization for expansion or construction of a marina, or maintenance dredging to \$100.

Fiscal Impact
There would be an indeterminate fiscal impact on the water management program in the Department of Environmental Quality. Actual revenue loss would depend on the number of nonprofit sponsored projects and the number of dredging operations conducted at nonprofit owned marinas. There would be no fiscal impact on local governmental units.
