- 4 to 750.315a and 750.372 to 750.376a.
- 5 (b) "Indian tribe" means that term as defined in section 4 of
- **6** the Indian gaming regulatory act, Public Law 100-497, 25
- 7 U.S.C. 2703.
- 8 Sec. 2. A compact between this state and an Indian tribe
- 9 that includes a provision relating to gambling is void unless it
- 10 is enacted as legislation pursuant to article IV of the state
- 11 constitution of 1963.
