

SENATE BILL No. 452

May 1, 2003, Introduced by Senators CROPSEY, HARDIMAN, BIRKHOLZ, KUIPERS,
VAN WOERKOM, STAMAS, JELINEK, BROWN and GARCIA and referred to the
Committee on Gaming and Casino Oversight.

A bill to provide for the manner of approval of a compact
made between this state and an Indian tribe.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:

2 (a) "Gambling" means an activity prohibited under chapter
3 XLIV or LV of the Michigan penal code, 1931 PA 328, MCL 750.301
4 to 750.315a and 750.372 to 750.376a.

5 (b) "Indian tribe" means that term as defined in section 4 of
6 the Indian gaming regulatory act, Public Law 100-497, 25
7 U.S.C. 2703.

8 Sec. 2. A compact between this state and an Indian tribe
9 that includes a provision relating to gambling is void unless it
10 is enacted as legislation pursuant to article IV of the state
11 constitution of 1963.
