

SENATE BILL No. 843

November 13, 2003, Introduced by Senators GILBERT, STAMAS, PATTERSON, VAN WOERKOM, TOY, GARCIA, BASHAM, CROSEY, BIRKHOLZ and BROWN and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled
"The code of criminal procedure,"
by amending section 12e of chapter XVII (MCL 777.12e), as added
by 2002 PA 34.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

CHAPTER XVII

Sec. 12e. This chapter applies to the following felonies
enumerated in sections 601 to 624b of chapter VI of the Michigan
vehicle code, 1949 PA 300, within chapter 257 of the Michigan
Compiled Laws:
