"An act to facilitate the inspection and reproduction of the records and files in the offices of the registers of deeds,"

by amending section 1 (MCL 565.551), as amended by 1994 PA 51.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. (1) A register of deeds shall furnish proper and
- 2 reasonable facilities for the inspection and examination of the
- 3 records and files in his or her office, and for making
- 4 memorandums or transcripts from the records and files during the
- 5 usual business hours, to an individual having a lawful purpose to
- **6** examine the records and files. However, the **The** custodian of
- 7 the records and files may make reasonable rules and regulations
- 8 with reference to the inspection and examination of the records
- 9 and files as is necessary to protect the records and files and to
- 10 prevent interference with the regular discharge of the duties of
- 11 the register of deeds.
