April 22, 2004, Introduced by Senators THOMAS and BIRKHOLZ and referred to the Committee on Finance.

A bill to amend 1967 PA 281, entitled "Income tax act of 1967,"

(MCL 206.1 to 206.532) by adding section 437.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 437. (1) For the 2005 tax year and each tax year after 2 the 2005 tax year, an individual may designate on his or her 3 annual return that a contribution of \$2.00 or more of his or her refund be credited to the prostate cancer research fund created 4 in the prostate cancer research fund act. 5 If an individual's refund is not sufficient to make a contribution under this section, the individual may designate a contribution amount and 7 that contribution amount shall be added to the individual's tax 8 liability for the tax year. 9

10 (2) The tax designation authorized in this section shall be 11 clearly and unambiguously printed on the first page of the state

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1 individual income tax return forms.

2 (3) Notwithstanding any other allocations or disbursements required by this act, each year that the contribution designation 3 4 under this section is in effect, an amount equal to the 5 cumulative designation made under this section, less the amount appropriated to the department to implement this section, shall 6 7 be appropriated from the general fund and deposited in the prostate cancer research fund created in the prostate cancer 8 research fund act and shall be used solely for the purposes of 9 that fund. 10 11 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take 12 effect unless Senate Bill No. 1161 of the 92nd Legislature is enacted into 13

14 law.

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
