A resolution for the Honorable Dale Sheltroun.

Whereas, It is a privilege to extend the congratulations of the House of Representatives to the Honorable Dale Sheltroun as he completes six productive years with this legislative body. Representative Sheltroun's talent, experience, and hard work have contributed to the development of sound policies in Michigan.
