SENATE SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 463

A bill to amend 1978 PA 33, entitled

"An act to prohibit the dissemination, exhibiting, or displaying of certain sexually explicit matter to minors; to prohibit certain misrepresentations facilitating the dissemination of sexually explicit matter to minors; to provide penalties; to provide for declaratory judgments and injunctive relief in certain instances; to impose certain duties upon prosecuting attorneys and the circuit court; to preempt local units of government from proscribing certain conduct; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

by amending section 3 (MCL 722.673), as amended by 2003 PA 192.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3. As used in this -act PART:
- 2 (A) "COMPUTER" MEANS ANY CONNECTED, DIRECTLY INTEROPERABLE OR
- 3 INTERACTIVE DEVICE, EQUIPMENT, OR FACILITY THAT USES A COMPUTER
- 4 PROGRAM OR OTHER INSTRUCTIONS TO PERFORM SPECIFIC OPERATIONS
- 5 INCLUDING LOGICAL, ARITHMETIC, OR MEMORY FUNCTIONS WITH OR ON
- 6 COMPUTER DATA OR A COMPUTER PROGRAM AND THAT CAN STORE, RETRIEVE,

- 1 ALTER, OR COMMUNICATE THE RESULTS OF THE OPERATIONS TO A PERSON,
- 2 COMPUTER PROGRAM, COMPUTER, COMPUTER SYSTEM, OR COMPUTER NETWORK.
- 3 (B) "COMPUTER NETWORK" MEANS THE INTERCONNECTION OF HARDWIRE
- 4 OR WIRELESS COMMUNICATION LINES WITH A COMPUTER THROUGH REMOTE
- 5 TERMINALS, OR A COMPLEX CONSISTING OF 2 OR MORE INTERCONNECTED
- 6 COMPUTERS.
- 7 (C) "COMPUTER PROGRAM" MEANS A SERIES OF INTERNAL OR EXTERNAL
- 8 INSTRUCTIONS COMMUNICATED IN A FORM ACCEPTABLE TO A COMPUTER THAT
- 9 DIRECTS THE FUNCTIONING OF A COMPUTER, COMPUTER SYSTEM, OR COMPUTER
- 10 NETWORK IN A MANNER DESIGNED TO PROVIDE OR PRODUCE PRODUCTS OR
- 11 RESULTS FROM THE COMPUTER, COMPUTER SYSTEM, OR COMPUTER NETWORK.
- 12 (D) "COMPUTER SYSTEM" MEANS A SET OF RELATED, CONNECTED OR
- 13 UNCONNECTED, COMPUTER EQUIPMENT, DEVICES, SOFTWARE, OR HARDWARE.
- 14 (E) "DEVICE" INCLUDES, BUT IS NOT LIMITED TO, AN ELECTRONIC,
- 15 MAGNETIC, ELECTROCHEMICAL, BIOCHEMICAL, HYDRAULIC, OPTICAL, OR
- 16 ORGANIC OBJECT THAT PERFORMS INPUT, OUTPUT, OR STORAGE FUNCTIONS BY
- 17 THE MANIPULATION OF ELECTRONIC, MAGNETIC, OR OTHER IMPULSES.
- 18 (F) —(a)— "Sexually explicit matter" means sexually explicit
- 19 visual material, sexually explicit verbal material, or sexually
- 20 explicit performance.
- 21 (G) (b) "Sexually explicit performance" means a motion
- 22 picture, VIDEO GAME, exhibition, show, representation, or other
- 23 presentation that, in whole or in part, depicts nudity, sexual
- 24 excitement, erotic fondling, sexual intercourse, or sadomasochistic
- 25 abuse.
- 26 (H) (c)— "Sexually explicit verbal material" means a book,
- 27 pamphlet, magazine, printed matter reproduced in any manner, or

- 1 sound recording that contains an explicit and detailed verbal
- 2 description or narrative account of sexual excitement, erotic
- 3 fondling, sexual intercourse, or sadomasochistic abuse.
- 4 (I) —(d) "Sexually explicit visual material" means a picture,
- 5 photograph, drawing, sculpture, motion picture film, VIDEO GAME, or
- 6 similar visual representation that depicts nudity, sexual
- 7 excitement, erotic fondling, sexual intercourse, or sadomasochistic
- 8 abuse, or a book, magazine, or pamphlet that contains such a visual
- 9 representation. An undeveloped photograph, mold, or similar visual
- 10 material may be sexually explicit material notwithstanding that
- 11 processing or other acts may be required to make its sexually
- 12 explicit content apparent.
- 13 (J) "VIDEO GAME" MEANS AN OBJECT OR DEVICE THAT STORES
- 14 RECORDED DATA OR INSTRUCTIONS GENERATED BY A PERSON WHO USES IT,
- 15 AND BY PROCESSING THE DATA OR INSTRUCTIONS CREATES AN INTERACTIVE
- 16 GAME CAPABLE OF BEING PLAYED, VIEWED, OR EXPERIENCED ON OR THROUGH
- 17 A COMPUTER, GAMING SYSTEM, GAME CONSOLE, OR OTHER TECHNOLOGY.
- 18 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect December
- **19** 1, 2005.
- 20 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
