A bill to amend 1988 PA 57, entitled

20 (a) Adopt bylaws and rules of administration to accomplish the21 purposes of this act.

(B) ADOPT ORDINANCES THAT ALLOW THE AUTHORITY TO ASSESS FEES
ON OWNERS OR OCCUPANTS OF PROPERTY WHO RECEIVE EMERGENCY SERVICES
TO COVER THE COSTS OF PROVIDING EMERGENCY SERVICES UNDER THIS ACT.
AN ORDINANCE ADOPTED UNDER THIS SUBDIVISION SHALL BE RESCINDED IF,
WITHIN 60 DAYS FROM THE DATE THE ORDINANCE IS ADOPTED, 1/3 OR MORE
OF THE MUNICIPALITIES AFFECTED BY THE ORDINANCE VOTE TO RESCIND THE

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1 ORDINANCE.

(C) (b) Apply for and accept grants, loans, or contributions
from the federal government or any of its agencies, the state, or
other public or private agencies to be used for any of the purposes
of this act and to do any and all things within its express or
implied powers necessary or desirable to secure that financial or
other aid or cooperation in the carrying out of any of the purposes
of this act.

9 (D) -(c) Enter into any contracts with other entities not
10 prohibited by law.

11 (E) (d) Investigate emergency services requirements, needs, 12 and programs and engage, by contract, consultants as may be 13 necessary and cooperate with the federal government, state, 14 political subdivisions, and other authorities in those 15 investigations.

16 (F) (e) Subject to the terms and conditions prescribed in 17 section 10, hire employees, attorneys, accountants, and consultants 18 as the authority considers necessary to carry out the purposes of 19 the authority.

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
