SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 6363

A bill to amend 1976 PA 390, entitled "Emergency management act,"

by amending section 5 (MCL 30.405), as amended by 1990 PA 50.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 5. (1) In addition to the general authority granted to
- 2 the governor by this act, the governor may, upon the declaration of
- 3 a state of disaster or a state of emergency do 1 or more of the
- 4 following:
- 5 (a) Suspend a regulatory statute, order, or rule prescribing
- 6 the procedures for conduct of state business, when strict
- 7 compliance with the statute, order, or rule would prevent, hinder,
- 8 or delay necessary action in coping with the disaster or emergency.
- 9 This power does not extend to the suspension of criminal process

- 1 and procedures.
- 2 (b) Utilize the available resources of the state and its
- 3 political subdivisions, and those of the federal government made
- 4 available to the state, as are reasonably necessary to cope with
- 5 the disaster or emergency.
- 6 (c) Transfer the direction, personnel, or functions of state
- 7 departments, agencies, or units thereof for the purpose of
- 8 performing or facilitating emergency management.
- 9 (d) Subject to appropriate compensation, as authorized by the
- 10 legislature, commandeer or utilize private property necessary to
- 11 cope with the disaster or emergency.
- (e) Direct and compel the evacuation of all or part of the
- 13 population from a stricken or threatened area within the state if
- 14 necessary for the preservation of life or other mitigation,
- 15 response, or recovery activities.
- 16 (f) Prescribe routes, modes, and destination of transportation
- in connection with an evacuation.
- 18 (g) Control ingress and egress to and from a stricken or
- 19 threatened area, removal of persons within the area, and the
- 20 occupancy of premises within the area.
- 21 (h) Suspend or limit the sale, dispensing, or transportation
- 22 of alcoholic beverages, firearms, explosives, and combustibles.
- (i) Provide for the availability and use of temporary
- 24 emergency housing.
- 25 (j) Direct all other actions which are necessary and
- 26 appropriate under the circumstances.
- 27 (2) SUBSECTION (1) DOES NOT AUTHORIZE THE SEIZURE, TAKING, OR

- 1 CONFISCATION OF LAWFULLY POSSESSED FIREARMS OR AMMUNITION.
- 2 (3) -(2) A person who willfully disobeys or interferes with
- 3 the implementation of a rule, order, or directive issued by the
- 4 governor pursuant to this section is guilty of a misdemeanor.
