## HOUSE BILL NO. 6364

A bill to amend 1945 PA 302, entitled

"An act authorizing the governor to proclaim a state of emergency, and to prescribe the powers and duties of the governor with respect thereto; and to prescribe penalties,"

by amending section 1 (MCL 10.31).

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1	Sec. 1. (1) During times of great public crisis, disaster,
2	rioting, catastrophe, or similar public emergency within the state,
3	or reasonable apprehension of immediate danger - thereof - OF A
4	PUBLIC EMERGENCY OF THAT KIND, when public safety is imperiled,
5	either upon application of the mayor of a city, sheriff of a
6	county, <b>OR</b> the commissioner of the Michigan state police $-$ , or
7	upon his <b>OR HER</b> own volition, the governor may proclaim a state of
8	emergency and designate the area involved. <del>Following such</del> AFTER

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1 MAKING THE proclamation or declaration, the governor may promulgate 2 such reasonable orders, rules, and regulations as he deems OR SHE CONSIDERS necessary to protect life and property ---- or to 3 4 bring the emergency situation within the affected area under 5 control. Without limiting the scope of the same, said THOSE orders, rules, and regulations may -provide - INCLUDE, BUT ARE NOT 6 LIMITED TO, PROVIDING for the control of traffic, including public 7 and private transportation, within the area or any section - thereof 8 9 OF THE AREA; designation of specific zones within the area in which 10 occupancy and use of buildings and ingress and egress of persons 11 and vehicles may be prohibited or regulated; control of places of 12 amusement and assembly ---- and of persons on public streets and thoroughfares; establishment of a curfew; control of the sale, 13 14 transportation, and use of alcoholic beverages and liquors; control of the possession, sale, carrying and use of firearms, 15 other dangerous weapons, and ammunition; and control of the 16 17 storage, use, and transportation of explosives or inflammable 18 materials or liquids deemed to be dangerous to public safety. - Such (2) THE orders, rules, and regulations - shall be PROMULGATED 19 20 UNDER SUBSECTION (1) ARE effective from the date and in the manner 21 prescribed in -such THE orders, rules, and regulations and shall 22 be made public as provided -therein- IN THE ORDERS, RULES, AND 23 **REGULATIONS**. - Such - THE orders, rules, and regulations may be amended, modified, or rescinded, in -like- THE manner IN WHICH THEY 24 25 WERE PROMULGATED, from time to time by the governor during the 26 pendency of the emergency, but shall cease to be in effect upon 27 declaration by the governor that the emergency no longer exists.

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(3) SUBSECTION (1) DOES NOT AUTHORIZE THE SEIZURE, TAKING, OR 1 CONFISCATION OF LAWFULLY POSSESSED FIREARMS, AMMUNITION, OR OTHER 2 3 WEAPONS.

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
