A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled
"Public health code,"
by amending section 2233 (MCL 333.2233), as amended by 1996 PA 67.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 2233. ~~(1)~~ The department may promulgate rules necessary
2 or appropriate to implement and carry out the duties or functions
3 vested by law in the department. **A RULE PROMULGATED UNDER THIS ACT**
4 **OR AN EXCEPTION TO A RULE PROMULGATED UNDER THIS ACT SHALL NOT**
5 **DISCRIMINATE IN FAVOR OF OR AGAINST ANY PROVIDER, FACILITY, OR**
6 **EMPLOYER LICENSED UNDER THIS ACT BASED <<ON>> THE PRESENCE OF, OR**
7 **LACK OF, A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT WITH EMPLOYEES, NOR**
8 **SHALL COLLECTIVE BARGAINING STATUS, LEVEL OF WAGES, OR FRINGE**
9 **BENEFITS BE USED TO DEMONSTRATE OR EXCUSE COMPLIANCE WITH STATE**
