

HOUSE BILL No. 6048

May 10, 2006, Introduced by Reps. Moore, Pastor, Meyer and Booher and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources, Great Lakes, Land Use, and Environment.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled
"Public health code,"
(MCL 333.1101 to 333.25211) by adding section 12703a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 12703A. (1) IF A RESIDENCE HAS AN INADEQUATE SUPPLY OF
2 WATER AND A COMMUNITY SUPPLY IS NOT AVAILABLE, A PERSON MAY USE AN
3 IN-GROUND HAULED WATER SYSTEM TO SUPPLY WATER TO THAT RESIDENCE FOR
4 DRINKING OR HOUSEHOLD PURPOSES.

5 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:

6 (A) "COMMUNITY SUPPLY" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION 2
7 OF THE SAFE DRINKING WATER ACT, 1976 PA 399, MCL 325.1002.

8 (B) "INADEQUATE SUPPLY OF WATER" MEANS A WATER SUPPLY THAT THE
9 LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT DETERMINES HAS AN INADEQUATE QUANTITY OF
10 WATER AVAILABLE OR MEETS OR EXCEEDS ANY OF THE FOLLOWING

1 CONTAMINANT LEVELS:

2 (i) CHLORIDE 250 MG/L.

3 (ii) HARDNESS 250 MG/L.

4 (iii) IRON 0.5 MG/L.

5 (iv) SODIUM 160 MG/L.

6 (v) SULFATE 250 MG/L.
