

# HOUSE BILL No. 6294

June 29, 2006, Introduced by Reps. Casperson, Baxter, Farhat, Marleau, Nitz, Ball, Emmons, LaJoy, Caul, Shaffer and Pearce and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to make, supplement, and adjust appropriations for the department of community health for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2006; to provide for the expenditure of the appropriations; and to prescribe certain conditions for the appropriations.

LINE-ITEM APPROPRIATIONS

Sec. 101. There is appropriated for the department of community health for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2006, from the following funds:

Statewide network cord blood stem cell banks.....	\$	<u>5,000,000</u>

3 PROVISIONS CONCERNING APPROPRIATIONS

4 GENERAL SECTIONS

5 Sec. 201. Pursuant to section 30 of article IX of the state  
6 constitution of 1963, total state spending under part 1 for fiscal  
7 year 2005-2006 is \$5,000,000.00. State payments to local units of  
8 government under this act are \$0.

9 Sec. 202. The appropriations made and the expenditures  
10 authorized under this act and the departments, agencies,  
11 commissions, boards, offices, and programs for which an  
12 appropriation is made under this act are subject to the management  
13 and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101 to 18.1594.

14 STATEWIDE NETWORK CORD BLOOD STEM CELL BANKS

15 Sec. 301. From the funds appropriated in part 1, the  
16 department shall establish a statewide network of cord blood stem  
17 cell banks and award grants to qualified stem cell banks. The funds  
18 shall also be used to promote the statewide network of cord blood  
19 stem cell banks and to increase awareness and knowledge about the  
20 benefits of cord blood and stem cell research. The funds shall not  
21 be used for any fixed capital costs, including, but not limited to,  
22 new buildings or building additions.
