

HOUSE BILL No. 6354

August 16, 2006, Introduced by Rep. Miller and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled "Michigan liquor control code of 1998," by amending sections 1101a and 1114 (MCL 436.2101a and 436.2114), section 1101a as added by 1998 PA 251 and section 1114 as added by 2004 PA 134; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 1101a. A petition under section 1101 ~~—~~ OR 1107, ~~—1111,~~
 2 ~~or 1113,~~ including the circulation and signing of the petition, is
 3 subject to section 488 of the Michigan election law, 1954 PA 116,
 4 MCL 168.488. A person who violates a provision of the Michigan
 5 election law, 1954 PA 116, MCL 168.1 to 168.992, applicable to a
 6 petition described in this section is subject to the penalties
 7 prescribed for that violation in the Michigan election law, 1954 PA

1 116, MCL 168.1 to 168.992.

2 Sec. 1114. (1) Notwithstanding R 436.1403 and R 436.1503 of
3 the Michigan administrative code and except as otherwise provided
4 under this act or rule of the commission, an on-premises and an
5 off-premises licensee shall not sell, give away, or furnish
6 alcoholic liquor between the hours of 2 a.m. and 7 a.m. **EST** on any
7 day. ~~and shall not sell, give away, or furnish alcoholic liquor~~
8 ~~between the hours of 2 a.m. and 12 noon, EST, on Sunday. An on-~~
9 ~~premises and an off-premises licensee shall not sell, give away, or~~
10 ~~furnish spirits between the hours of 2 a.m. and 12 midnight on~~
11 ~~Sunday, unless issued a Sunday sales permit by the commission that~~
12 ~~allows the licensee to sell spirits on Sunday between the hours of~~
13 ~~12 noon, EST, and 12 midnight.~~

14 ~~—— (2) For purposes of R 436.1403 and R 436.1503 of the Michigan~~
15 ~~administrative code, 12 noon on Sunday is considered 12 noon on~~
16 ~~Sunday, EST, for any licensee located in the central time zone.~~

17 (2) ~~—(3)—~~ A reference to the time of day under this act or a
18 rule of the commission includes daylight savings time, when
19 observed.

20 Enacting section 1. Sections 1111, 1113, and 1115 of the
21 Michigan liquor control code of 1998, 1998 PA 58, MCL 436.2111,
22 436.2113, and 436.2115, are repealed.
