

SENATE BILL No. 548

May 31, 2005, Introduced by Senator JOHNSON and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend 1972 PA 222, entitled

"An act to provide for an official personal identification card; to provide for its form, issuance and use; to regulate the use and disclosure of information obtained from the card; to prescribe the powers and duties of the secretary of state; to prescribe fees; to prescribe certain penalties for violations; and to provide an appropriation for certain purposes,"

by amending section 7 (MCL 28.297), as added by 1997 PA 99.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 7. (1) The secretary of state may provide a commercial
2 look-up service of records maintained under this act. For each
3 individual record looked up, the secretary of state shall charge a
4 fee specified annually by the legislature, or if the legislature
5 does not specify a fee, a market-based price established by the
6 secretary of state. The secretary of state shall process a

1 commercial look-up request only if the request is in a form or
2 format as prescribed by the secretary of state. ~~The secretary of~~
3 ~~state may use fee revenues received under this subsection for~~
4 ~~necessary expenses.~~ **BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2005, THE FEES COLLECTED**
5 **UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE CREDITED TO THE TRANSPORTATION**
6 **ADMINISTRATION COLLECTION FUND CREATED IN SECTION 810B OF THE**
7 **MICHIGAN VEHICLE CODE, 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.810B.**

8 (2) The secretary of state shall establish and maintain a
9 computerized central file of the information contained on
10 application forms received under this act. The computerized central
11 file shall be interfaced with the law enforcement information
12 network as provided in the L.E.I.N. policy council act of 1974,
13 1974 PA 163, MCL 28.211 to 28.216.

14 (3) Except as provided in section 10(2), the secretary of
15 state shall not provide an entire computerized central file or
16 other file of records maintained under this act to a
17 nongovernmental person or entity, unless the purchaser pays the
18 prescribed fee for each individual record contained within the
19 computerized file.

20 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect October
21 1, 2005.

22 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
23 unless all of the following bills of the 93rd Legislature are
24 enacted into law:
