

# SENATE BILL No. 1172

March 21, 2006, Introduced by Senator BROWN and referred to the Committee on Technology and Energy.

A bill to amend 1986 PA 32, entitled "Emergency telephone service enabling act," by amending sections 201, 301, and 717 (MCL 484.1201, 484.1301, and 484.1717), section 201 as amended by 1999 PA 78, section 301 as amended by 1994 PA 29, and section 717 as added by 1999 PA 79.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           Sec. 201. Except as provided in sections 407 to 412, a  
 2 universal emergency number service system shall not be implemented  
 3 ~~pursuant to~~ **UNDER** this act unless a tariff exists for each service  
 4 supplier designated by the final 9-1-1 service plan to provide 9-1-  
 5 1 service in the universal emergency number system.

6           Sec. 301. (1) The board of commissioners of a county may  
 7 establish an emergency telephone district within all or part of the

1 county and may cause 9-1-1 service to be implemented within ~~such~~  
2 **THE** emergency telephone district ~~pursuant to~~ **UNDER** this act.

3 (2) The board of commissioners of a county all or part of  
4 which is operating an existing emergency telephone service may  
5 modify the existing emergency telephone service or may alter the  
6 scope or method of financing of 9-1-1 service within all or part of  
7 the county by establishing an emergency telephone district and  
8 causing 9-1-1 service to be implemented within ~~such~~ **THE** emergency  
9 telephone district ~~pursuant to~~ **UNDER** this act.

10 (3) The board of commissioners of a county may create an  
11 emergency telephone district board and delegate certain powers to  
12 the board.

13 (4) If the board of commissioners of a county has created  
14 multiple emergency telephone districts ~~prior to the effective date~~  
15 ~~of this subsection~~ **BEFORE MARCH 2, 1994**, the emergency telephone  
16 districts created shall receive all operational funds collected by  
17 the service supplier of the district and operate the systems as  
18 provided by this act.

19 Sec. 717. This act is repealed effective December 31, ~~2006~~  
20 **2010**.
