

SENATE BILL No. 1243

May 4, 2006, Introduced by Senators CASSIS, SANBORN, KUIPERS and PATTERSON and referred to the Committee on Government Operations.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 388, entitled
"Michigan campaign finance act,"
(MCL 169.201 to 169.282) by adding section 32a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 32A. (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (5), A
2 CANDIDATE COMMITTEE SHALL REPORT A CONTRIBUTION WITHIN 7 BUSINESS
3 DAYS OF RECEIVING THE CONTRIBUTION. THE CONTRIBUTION SHALL BE
4 REPORTED IN THE FORM REQUIRED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE. A REPORT
5 UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL CONTAIN THE INFORMATION REQUIRED BY
6 SECTION 26(1)(E), (G), AND (H) AND (6) FOR THE CONTRIBUTION.

7 (2) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (5), A CANDIDATE
8 COMMITTEE SHALL REPORT AN EXPENDITURE WITHIN 10 BUSINESS DAYS OF
9 MAKING THE EXPENDITURE. THE EXPENDITURE SHALL BE REPORTED IN THE
10 FORM REQUIRED BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE. A REPORT UNDER THIS

1 SUBSECTION SHALL CONTAIN THE INFORMATION REQUIRED BY SECTION
2 26(1)(J) AND (3) FOR THE EXPENDITURE.

3 (3) A REPORT UNDER THIS SECTION MAY REPORT MULTIPLE
4 CONTRIBUTIONS OR EXPENDITURES ON THE SAME FORM, SHALL CONTAIN THE
5 INFORMATION REQUIRED BY SECTION 26(1)(A), AND SHALL BE FILED WITH
6 THE OFFICIALS DESIGNATED IN SECTION 36 TO RECEIVE THE COMMITTEE'S
7 CAMPAIGN STATEMENTS.

8 (4) REPORTING A CONTRIBUTION OR EXPENDITURE UNDER THIS SECTION
9 DOES NOT EXCUSE OTHER REPORTING OF THE CONTRIBUTION OR EXPENDITURE
10 IN A CAMPAIGN STATEMENT OR OTHERWISE AS REQUIRED BY THIS ACT.

11 (5) A CANDIDATE COMMITTEE THAT FILES A WRITTEN STATEMENT UNDER
12 SECTION 24(5) NEED NOT FILE A REPORT UNDER THIS SECTION UNLESS IT
13 HAS RECEIVED OR EXPENDED AN AMOUNT IN EXCESS OF \$1,000.00. IF THE
14 COMMITTEE RECEIVES OR EXPENDS AN AMOUNT IN EXCESS OF \$1,000.00, THE
15 COMMITTEE IS THEN SUBJECT TO THIS SECTION.

16 (6) A CANDIDATE COMMITTEE, CANDIDATE, TREASURER, OR OTHER
17 INDIVIDUAL DESIGNATED AS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE COMMITTEE'S RECORD
18 KEEPING, REPORT PREPARATION, OR REPORT FILING WHO FAILS TO FILE A
19 REPORT AS REQUIRED BY THIS SECTION SHALL PAY A LATE FILING FEE, NOT
20 TO EXCEED \$2,000.00, DETERMINED AS FOLLOWS:

21 (A) TWENTY-FIVE DOLLARS FOR EACH BUSINESS DAY THE REPORT
22 REMAINS UNFILED.

23 (B) AN ADDITIONAL \$25.00 FOR EACH BUSINESS DAY AFTER THE FIRST
24 3 BUSINESS DAYS THE REPORT REMAINS UNFILED.

25 (C) AN ADDITIONAL \$50.00 FOR EACH BUSINESS DAY AFTER THE FIRST
26 10 BUSINESS DAYS THE REPORT REMAINS UNFILED.
