FY 2007-08 SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATIONS House Bill 5344 (H-8) CR-1* Floor Summary: Conference Report



Overview

House Bill 5344 is a fiscal year 2007-08 supplemental budget bill. The conference report for the bill contains appropriations totaling \$143.9 million Gross and \$42.3 million GF/GP. An attached table compares the appropriation items in the conference report with the items recommended by the State Budget Office and the items included in the House- and Senate-passed versions of the bill.

The bill concurs with the SBO recommendation for a negative appropriation of \$30.0 million GF/GP for projected debt service savings in the Department of Treasury budget. Those savings partially offset the positive GF/GP appropriations of \$72.3 million in the bill.

A second attached table compares boilerplate items in the conference report with the items recommended by the State Budget Office and the items included in the House- and Senate-passed versions of the bill.
