## SENATE BILL No. 451

April 26, 2007, Introduced by Senators BASHAM and CASSIS and referred to the Committee on Economic Development and Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled "Revised judicature act of 1961," by amending section 4701 (MCL 600.4701), as amended by 2002 PA 142, and by adding section 2975a.

- 21 (f) "Substituted proceeds of a crime" means any property
- 22 obtained or any gain realized by the sale or exchange of proceeds
- 23 of a crime.
