HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 716

A bill to amend 2004 PA 47, entitled "Medical records access act," by amending section 3 (MCL 333.26263).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Authorized representative" means either ANY of the
- 3 following:
- 4 (i) A person empowered by the patient by explicit written
- 5 authorization to act on the patient's behalf to access, disclose,
- 6 or consent to the disclosure of the patient's medical record, in
- 7 accordance with this act.
- 8 (ii) If the patient is deceased, $\frac{\text{his}}{\text{ANY}}$ OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 9 (A) HIS or her personal representative. or his

- 1 (B) HIS or her heirs at law or the INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED
- 2 TO, HIS OR HER SPOUSE.
- 3 (C) THE beneficiary of the patient's life insurance policy, to
- 4 the extent provided by section 2157 of the revised judicature act
- **5** of 1961, 1961 PA 236, MCL 600.2157.
- 6 (iii) FOR THE PURPOSE OF OBTAINING A COPY OF AN AUTOPSY REPORT
- 7 REGARDING A DECEASED PATIENT, ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 8 (A) THE DECEASED PATIENT'S HEIRS AT LAW INCLUDING, BUT NOT
- 9 LIMITED TO, THE DECEASED PATIENT'S SPOUSE.
- 10 (B) THE DECEASED PATIENT'S PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE.
- 11 (C) THE BENEFICIARY OF THE DECEASED PATIENT'S LIFE INSURANCE
- 12 POLICY, TO THE EXTENT PROVIDED BY SECTION 2157 OF THE REVISED
- 13 JUDICATURE ACT OF 1961, 1961 PA 236, MCL 600.2157.
- 14 (b) "Detroit consumer price index" means the most
- 15 comprehensive index of consumer prices available for the Detroit
- 16 area from the bureau of labor statistics of the United States
- 17 department of labor.
- 18 (c) "Guardian" means an individual who is appointed under
- 19 section 5306 of the estates and protected individuals code, 1998 PA
- 20 386, MCL 700.5306, to the extent that the scope of the quardianship
- 21 includes the authority to act on the individual's behalf with
- 22 regard to his or her health care. Guardian includes an individual
- 23 who is appointed as the guardian of a minor under section 5202 or
- 24 5204 of the estates and protected individuals code, 1998 PA 386,
- 25 MCL 700.5202 and 700.5204, or under the mental health code, 1974 PA
- 26 258, MCL 330.1001 to 330.2106, to the extent that the scope of the
- 27 guardianship includes the authority to act on the individual's

- 1 behalf with regard to his or her health care.
- 2 (d) "Health care" means any care, service, or procedure
- 3 provided by a health care provider or health facility to diagnose,
- 4 treat, or maintain a patient's physical condition, or that affects
- 5 the structure or a function of the human body.
- 6 (e) "Health care provider" means a person who is licensed or
- 7 registered or otherwise authorized under article 15 of the public
- 8 health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.16101 to 333.18838, to provide
- 9 health care in the ordinary course of business or practice of a
- 10 health profession. Health care provider does not include a person
- 11 who provides health care solely through the sale or dispensing of
- 12 drugs or medical devices or a psychiatrist, psychologist, social
- worker, or professional counselor who provides only mental health
- 14 services.
- 15 (f) "Health facility" means a health facility or agency
- 16 licensed under article 17 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368,
- 17 MCL 333.20101 to 333.22260, or any other organized entity where a
- 18 health care provider provides health care to patients.
- 19 (q) "Maintain", as related to medical records, means to hold,
- 20 possess, preserve, retain, store, or control medical records.
- 21 (h) "Medicaid" means that term as defined in section 2701 of
- 22 the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.2701.
- (i) "Medical record" means information oral or recorded in any
- 24 form or medium that pertains to a patient's health care, medical
- 25 history, diagnosis, prognosis, or medical condition and that is
- 26 maintained by a health care provider or health facility in the
- 27 process of CARING FOR the patient's health.

- 1 (j) "Medical records company" means a person who stores,
- 2 locates, or copies medical records for a health care provider or
- 3 health facility under a contract or agreement with that health care
- 4 provider or health facility and charges a fee for providing medical
- 5 records to a patient or his or her authorized representative for
- 6 that health care provider or health facility.
- 7 (k) "Medically indigent individual" means that term as defined
- 8 under IN section 106 of the social welfare act, 1939 PA 280, MCL
- 9 400.106.
- 10 (l) "Medicare" means that term as defined in section 2701 of
- 11 the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.2701.
- 12 (m) "Minor" means an individual who is less than 18 years of
- 13 age, but does not include an individual who is emancipated under
- 14 section 4 of 1968 PA 293, MCL 722.4.
- 15 (n) "Patient" means an individual who receives or has received
- 16 health care from a health care provider or health facility. Patient
- 17 includes a guardian, if appointed, and a parent, guardian, or
- 18 person acting in loco parentis, if the individual is a minor,
- 19 unless the minor lawfully obtained health care without the consent
- 20 or notification of a parent, guardian, or other person acting in
- 21 loco parentis, in which case the minor has the exclusive right to
- 22 exercise the rights of a patient under this act with respect to
- 23 those medical records relating to that care.
- 24 (o) "Person" means an individual, corporation, estate, trust,
- 25 partnership, association, joint venture, government, governmental
- 26 subdivision or agency, or other legal or commercial entity.
- (p) "Personal representative" means that term as defined in

- 1 section 1106 of the estates and protected individuals code, 1998 PA
- 2 386, MCL 700.1106.
- 3 (q) "Third party payer" means a public or private health care
- 4 payment or benefits program including, but not limited to, all of
- 5 the following:
- 6 (i) A health insurer.
- 7 (ii) A nonprofit health care corporation.
- 8 (iii) A health maintenance organization.
- 9 (iv) A preferred provider organization.
- 10 (v) A nonprofit dental care corporation.
- 11 (vi) Medicaid or medicare.
