HOUSE BILL No. 4528

March 22, 2007, Introduced by Reps. Robert Jones and Condino and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled

"Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 307 (MCL 257.307), as amended by 2006 PA 298.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 307. (1) An applicant for an operator's or chauffeur's
- 2 license shall supply a birth certificate attesting to his or her
- 3 age or other sufficient documents or identification as the
- 4 secretary of state may require. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL
- 5 ACCEPT AS 1 OF THE REQUIRED IDENTIFICATION DOCUMENTS AN
- 6 IDENTIFICATION CARD ISSUED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS TO
- 7 PRISONERS WHO ARE PLACED ON PAROLE OR RELEASED FROM A
- 8 CORRECTIONAL FACILITY, CONTAINING THE PRISONER'S NAME,
- 9 PHOTOGRAPH, AND OTHER INFORMATION IDENTIFYING THE PRISONER AS

- 1 PROVIDED IN SECTION 37(4) OF THE CORRECTIONS CODE OF 1953, 1953
- 2 PA 232, MCL 791.237. An application for an operator's or
- 3 chauffeur's license shall be made in a manner prescribed by the
- 4 secretary of state and shall contain all of the following:
- 5 (a) The applicant's full name, date of birth, residence
- 6 address, height, sex, eye color, signature, and, beginning
- 7 January 1, 2007, intent to be an organ donor, other information
- 8 required or permitted on the license under this chapter, and, to
- 9 the extent required to comply with federal law, the applicant's
- 10 social security number. The applicant may provide a mailing
- 11 address if the applicant receives mail at an address different
- 12 from his or her residence address.
- 13 (b) The following notice shall be included to inform the
- 14 applicant that under sections 5090 and 509r of the Michigan
- 15 election law, 1954 PA 116, MCL 168.5090 and 168.509r, the
- 16 secretary of state is required to use the residence address
- 17 provided on this application as the applicant's residence address
- 18 on the qualified voter file for voter registration and voting:
- 19 "NOTICE: Michigan law requires that the same address
- 20 be used for voter registration and driver license
- 21 purposes. Therefore, if the residence address
- you provide in this application differs from your
- voter registration address as it appears on the
- 24 qualified voter file, the secretary of state
- 25 will automatically change your voter registration
- 26 to match the residence address on this application,
- after which your voter registration at your former
- address will no longer be valid for voting purposes.

- 1 A new voter registration card, containing the
- information of your polling place, will be provided
- 3 to you by the clerk of the jurisdiction where your
- 4 residence address is located.".
- 5 (c) For an original or renewal operator's or chauffeur's
- 6 license with a vehicle group designation or indorsement, the
- 7 names of all states where the applicant has been licensed to
- 8 drive any type of motor vehicle during the previous 10 years.
- 9 (d) For an operator's or chauffeur's license with a vehicle
- 10 group designation or indorsement, the following certifications by
- 11 the applicant:
- 12 (i) The applicant meets the applicable federal driver
- 13 qualification requirements under 49 CFR part 391 if the applicant
- 14 operates or intends to operate in interstate commerce or meets
- 15 the applicable qualifications of the department of state police
- 16 under the motor carrier safety act of 1963, 1963 PA 181, MCL
- 17 480.11 to 480.25, if the applicant operates or intends to operate
- 18 in intrastate commerce.
- 19 (ii) The vehicle in which the applicant will take the driving
- 20 skills tests is representative of the type of vehicle the
- 21 applicant operates or intends to operate.
- 22 (iii) The applicant is not subject to disqualification by the
- 23 United States secretary of transportation, or a suspension,
- 24 revocation, or cancellation under any state law for conviction of
- 25 an offense described in section 312f or 319b.
- 26 (iv) The applicant does not have a driver's license from more
- 27 than 1 state or jurisdiction.

- 1 (e) An applicant for an operator's or chauffeur's license
- 2 with a vehicle group designation and a hazardous material
- 3 indorsement shall provide his or her fingerprints as prescribed
- 4 by state and federal law.
- 5 (2) Except as provided in this subsection, an applicant for
- 6 an operator's or chauffeur's license may have his or her image
- 7 and signature captured or reproduced when the application for the
- 8 license is made. An applicant required under section 5a of the
- 9 sex offenders registration act, 1994 PA 295, MCL 28.725a, to
- 10 maintain a valid operator's or chauffeur's license or official
- 11 state personal identification card shall have his or her image
- 12 and signature captured or reproduced when the application for the
- 13 license is made. The secretary of state shall acquire by purchase
- 14 or lease the equipment for capturing the images and signatures
- 15 and may furnish the equipment to a local unit authorized by the
- 16 secretary of state to license drivers. The secretary of state
- 17 shall acquire equipment purchased or leased pursuant to this
- 18 section under standard purchasing procedures of the department of
- 19 management and budget based on standards and specifications
- 20 established by the secretary of state. The secretary of state
- 21 shall not purchase or lease equipment until an appropriation for
- 22 the equipment has been made by the legislature. An image and
- 23 signature captured pursuant to this section shall appear on the
- 24 applicant's operator's or chauffeur's license. Except as provided
- 25 in this subsection, the secretary of state may retain and use a
- 26 person's image and signature described in this subsection only
- 27 for programs administered by the secretary of state. Except as

- 1 provided in this subsection, the secretary of state shall not use
- 2 a person's image or signature, or both, unless the person grants
- 3 written permission for that purpose to the secretary of state or
- 4 specific enabling legislation permitting the use is enacted into
- 5 law. A law enforcement agency of this state has access to
- 6 information retained by the secretary of state under this
- 7 subsection. The information may be utilized for any law
- 8 enforcement purpose unless otherwise prohibited by law. The
- 9 department of state police shall provide to the secretary of
- 10 state updated lists of persons required to be registered under
- 11 the sex offenders registration act, 1994 PA 295, MCL 28.721 to
- 12 28.736, and the secretary of state shall make the images of those
- 13 persons available to the department of state police as provided
- 14 in that act.
- 15 (3) An application shall contain a signature or verification
- 16 and certification by the applicant, as determined by the
- 17 secretary of state, and shall be accompanied by the proper fee.
- 18 The secretary of state shall collect the application fee with the
- 19 application. The secretary of state shall refund the application
- 20 fee to the applicant if the license applied for is denied, but
- 21 shall not refund the fee to an applicant who fails to complete
- 22 the examination requirements of the secretary of state within 90
- 23 days after the date of application for a license.
- 24 (4) In conjunction with the application for or, until
- 25 January 1, 2007, the issuance of an operator's or chauffeur's
- 26 license, the secretary of state shall do all of the following:
- (a) Provide the applicant with all of the following:

- 1 (i) Information explaining the applicant's right to make an
- 2 anatomical gift in the event of death in accordance with section
- **3** 310.
- 4 (ii) Information describing the organ, tissue, and eye donor
- 5 registry program. The information required under this
- 6 subparagraph includes the address and telephone number of
- 7 Michigan's federally designated organ procurement organization or
- 8 its successor organization.
- 9 (iii) Information giving the applicant the opportunity to be
- 10 placed on the registry described in subparagraph (ii).
- 11 (b) Provide the applicant with the opportunity to specify on
- 12 his or her operator's or chauffeur's license that he or she is
- 13 willing to make an anatomical gift in the event of death in
- 14 accordance with section 310.
- 15 (c) Inform the applicant that, if he or she indicates to the
- 16 secretary of state under this section a willingness to have his
- 17 or her name placed on the registry described in subdivision
- 18 (a) (ii), the secretary of state will mark the applicant's record
- 19 for the registry.
- 20 (d) Provide the applicant with the opportunity to make a
- 21 donation of \$1.00 or more to the organ and tissue donation
- 22 education fund created under section 217o. A donation made under
- 23 this subdivision shall be deposited in the state treasury to the
- 24 credit of the organ and tissue donation education fund.
- 25 (5) The secretary of state may fulfill the requirements of
- 26 subsection (4) by 1 or more of the following methods:
- 27 (a) Providing printed material enclosed with a mailed notice

- 1 for an operator's or chauffeur's license renewal or the issuance
- 2 of an operator's or chauffeur's license.
- 3 (b) Providing printed material to an applicant who
- 4 personally appears at a secretary of state branch office.
- 5 (c) Through electronic information transmittals for
- 6 operator's and chauffeur's licenses processed by electronic
- 7 means.
- 8 (6) Until January 1, 2007, if an applicant indicates a
- 9 willingness under this section to have his or her name placed on
- 10 the organ donor registry described in subsection (4) (a) (ii), the
- 11 secretary of state shall within 10 days forward the applicant's
- 12 name, and address, and date of birth to the organ donor registry
- 13 maintained by Michigan's federally designated organ procurement
- 14 organization or its successor organization. The secretary of
- 15 state may forward information under this subsection by mail or by
- 16 electronic means. The secretary of state shall not maintain a
- 17 record of the name or address of an individual who indicates a
- 18 willingness to have his or her name placed on the organ donor
- 19 registry after forwarding that information to the organ donor
- 20 registry under this subsection. Information about an applicant's
- 21 indication of a willingness to have his or her name placed on the
- 22 organ donor registry that is obtained by the secretary of state
- 23 under subsection (4) and forwarded under this subsection is
- 24 exempt from disclosure under section 13(1)(d) of the freedom of
- 25 information act, 1976 PA 442, MCL 15.243. Beginning January 1,
- 26 2007, the secretary of state shall maintain a record of an
- 27 individual who indicates a willingness to have his or her name

- 1 placed on the registry described in subsection (4)(a)(ii).
- 2 Information about an applicant's indication of a willingness to
- 3 have his or her name placed on the registry that is obtained by
- 4 the secretary of state under subsection (4) and forwarded under
- 5 subsection (14) is exempt from disclosure under section 13(1)(d)
- 6 of the freedom of information act, 1976 PA 442, MCL 15.243.
- 7 (7) If an application is received from a person previously
- 8 licensed in another jurisdiction, the secretary of state shall
- 9 request a copy of the applicant's driving record and other
- 10 available information from the national driver register. When
- 11 received, the driving record and other available information
- 12 become a part of the driver's record in this state.
- 13 (8) If an application is received for an original, renewal,
- 14 or upgrade of a vehicle group designation or indorsement, the
- 15 secretary of state shall request the person's complete driving
- 16 record from all states where the applicant was previously
- 17 licensed to drive any type of motor vehicle over the last 10
- 18 years before issuing a vehicle group designation or indorsement
- 19 to the applicant. If the applicant does not hold a valid
- 20 commercial motor vehicle driver license from a state where he or
- 21 she was licensed in the last 10 years, this complete driving
- 22 record request must be made not earlier than 24 hours before the
- 23 secretary of state issues the applicant a vehicle group
- 24 designation or indorsement. For all other drivers, this request
- 25 must be made not earlier than 10 days before the secretary of
- 26 state issues the applicant a vehicle group designation or
- 27 indorsement. The secretary of state shall also check the

- 1 applicant's driving record with the national driver register and
- 2 the federal commercial driver license information system before
- 3 issuing that group designation or indorsement. If the application
- 4 is for the renewal of a vehicle group designation or indorsement,
- 5 and if the secretary of state enters on the person's historical
- 6 driving record maintained under section 204a a notation that the
- 7 request was made and the date of the request, the secretary of
- 8 state is required to request the applicant's complete driving
- 9 record from other states only once under this section.
- 10 (9) Except for a vehicle group designation or indorsement or
- 11 as provided in this subsection or section 314(5), the secretary
- 12 of state may issue a renewal operator's or chauffeur's license
- 13 for 1 additional 4-year period by mail or by other methods
- 14 prescribed by the secretary of state. The secretary of state may
- 15 check the applicant's driving record through the national driver
- 16 register and the commercial driver license information system
- 17 before issuing a license under this section. The secretary of
- 18 state shall issue a renewal license only in person if the person
- 19 is a person required under section 5a of the sex offenders
- 20 registration act, 1994 PA 295, MCL 28.725a, to maintain a valid
- 21 operator's or chauffeur's license or official state personal
- 22 identification card. If a license is renewed by mail or by other
- 23 method, the secretary of state shall issue evidence of renewal to
- 24 indicate the date the license expires in the future. The
- 25 department of state police shall provide to the secretary of
- 26 state updated lists of persons required under section 5a of the
- 27 sex offenders registration act, 1994 PA 295, MCL 28.725a, to

- 1 maintain a valid operator's or chauffeur's license or official
- 2 state personal identification card.
- 3 (10) Upon request, the secretary of state shall provide an
- 4 information manual to an applicant explaining how to obtain a
- 5 vehicle group designation or indorsement. The manual shall
- 6 contain the information required under 49 CFR part 383.
- 7 (11) The secretary of state shall not disclose a social
- 8 security number obtained under subsection (1) to another person
- 9 except for use for 1 or more of the following purposes:
- 10 (a) Compliance with 49 USC 31301 to 31317 and regulations
- 11 and state law and rules related to this chapter.
- 12 (b) Through the law enforcement information network, to
- 13 carry out the purposes of section 466(a) of the social security
- 14 act, 42 USC 666, in connection with matters relating to
- 15 paternity, child support, or overdue child support.
- 16 (c) To check an applicant's driving record through the
- 17 national driver register and the commercial driver license
- 18 information system when issuing a license under this act.
- 19 (d) With the department of community health, for comparison
- 20 with vital records maintained by the department of community
- 21 health under part 28 of the public health code, 1978 PA 368, MCL
- 22 333.2801 to 333.2899.
- (e) As otherwise required by law.
- 24 (12) The secretary of state shall not display a person's
- 25 social security number on the person's operator's or chauffeur's
- 26 license.
- 27 (13) A requirement under this section to include a social

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- 1 security number on an application does not apply to an applicant
- 2 who demonstrates he or she is exempt under law from obtaining a
- 3 social security number or to an applicant who for religious
- 4 convictions is exempt under law from disclosure of his or her
- 5 social security number under these circumstances. The secretary
- 6 of state shall inform the applicant of this possible exemption.
- 7 (14) Beginning January 1, 2007, the secretary of state shall
- 8 maintain the organ, tissue, and eye donor registry in a manner
- 9 that provides electronic access, including, but not limited to,
- 10 transfer of data to this state's federally designated organ
- 11 procurement organizations, their successor organizations, and
- 12 tissue and eye banks with limitations on the use of and access to
- 13 the donor registry as determined by the secretary of state.
- 14 (15) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL HAVE ELECTRONIC ACCESS TO
- 15 PRISONER BIOGRAPHY INFORMATION MAINTAINED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 16 CORRECTIONS FOR THE PURPOSE OF VERIFYING THE IDENTITY OF A
- 17 PRISONER WHO APPLIES FOR AN OPERATOR'S OR CHAUFFEUR'S LICENSE
- 18 UNDER SUBSECTION (1).
