## SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 4468

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 601b (MCL 257.601b), as amended by 2003 PA 314.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 601b. (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of this
- 2 act, a person responsible for a moving violation in a work zone, at
- 3 an emergency scene, or in a school zone during the period beginning
- 4 30 minutes before school in the morning and through 30 minutes
- 5 after school in the afternoon is subject to a fine that is double
- 6 the fine otherwise prescribed for that moving violation.
- 7 (2) A person who commits a moving violation IN A WORK ZONE for
- 8 which not fewer than 3 points are assigned under section 320a and
- 9 as a result causes injury to a ANOTHER person working in the work
- 10 zone is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not more

- 1 than \$1,000.00 or imprisonment for not more than 1 year, or both.
- 2 (3) A person who commits a moving violation IN A WORK ZONE for
- 3 which not fewer than 3 points are assigned under section 320a and
- 4 as a result causes death to a ANOTHER person working in the work
- 5 zone is guilty of a felony punishable by a fine of not more than
- 6 \$7,500.00 or by imprisonment for not more than 15 years, or both.
- 7 (4) Whenever practical, signs designed in compliance with the
- 8 uniform manual of traffic control devices shall be appropriately
- 9 placed at the work zone by the state transportation department or
- 10 road authority having jurisdiction over the work zone notifying
- 11 operators of vehicles of the increased fines and penalties provided
- 12 by this section for the protection and safety of construction
- 13 workers.
- 14 (4) (5) Subsections (2) and (3) do not apply if the injury or
- 15 death was caused by the negligence of the INJURED OR DECEASED
- 16 person working in the work zone.
- 17 (5) (6) As used in this section:
- 18 (a) "Emergency scene" means a traffic accident, a serious
- 19 incident caused by weather conditions, or another occurrence along
- 20 a highway or street for which a police officer, firefighter, or
- 21 emergency medical personnel are summoned to aid an injured victim.
- 22 (b) "Moving violation" means an act or omission prohibited
- 23 under this act or a local ordinance substantially corresponding to
- 24 this act that occurs while a person is operating a motor vehicle,
- 25 and for which the person is subject to a fine.
- (c) "School zone" means that term as defined in section 627a.
