SUBSTITUTE FOR HOUSE BILL NO. 5686

A bill to authorize the removal, capture, or lethal control of a gray wolf that is preying upon livestock under certain circumstances; and to provide for penalties.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. As used in this act:
- 2 (a) "Department" means the department of natural resources.
- 3 (b) "Livestock" means those species of animals used for human
- 4 food or fiber or those species of animals used for service to
- 5 humans. Livestock includes, but is not limited to, cattle, sheep,
- 6 new world camelids, goats, bison, privately owned cervids, ratites,
- 7 swine, equine, poultry, aquaculture, and rabbits.
- 8 Sec. 3. (1) The owner of livestock or his or her designated
- 9 agent may remove, capture, or, if deemed necessary, use lethal

- 1 means to destroy a gray wolf that is in the act of preying upon the
- 2 owner's livestock.
- 3 (2) The owner of the livestock or his or her designated agent
- 4 shall report the taking of a gray wolf to a department official as
- 5 soon as practicable, but not later than 12 hours after the taking.
- 6 A person who violates this subsection is guilty of a misdemeanor
- 7 punishable by imprisonment for not more than 90 days or a fine of
- 8 not less than \$100.00 or more than \$1,000.00, or both, and the
- 9 costs of prosecution.
- 10 (3) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (4), the owner
- 11 of the livestock or his or her designated agent shall retain
- 12 possession of a gray wolf taken until a department official is
- 13 available to take possession of and transfer the gray wolf to the
- 14 appropriate department personnel for examination. A person who
- 15 violates this subsection is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by
- 16 imprisonment for not more than 90 days or a fine of not less than
- 17 \$100.00 or more than \$1,000.00, or both, and the costs of
- 18 prosecution.
- 19 (4) If lethal means are used to destroy a gray wolf, a person
- 20 shall not move or disturb the deceased gray wolf until he or she
- 21 takes photographs of the deceased gray wolf and of the area where
- 22 lethal means were used to destroy the gray wolf. Copies of the
- 23 photographs taken by the person may be requested by the department
- 24 for examination. A person who violates this subsection is guilty of
- 25 a misdemeanor punishable by imprisonment for not more than 90 days
- or a fine of not less than \$100.00 or more than \$1,000.00, or both,
- 27 and the costs of prosecution.

- 1 (5) A department official shall respond to the scene where
- 2 lethal means were used to destroy a gray wolf not later than 12
- 3 hours after a department official is notified under subsection (2).
- 4 (6) The owner of the livestock or his or her designated agent
- 5 may report the taking of a gray wolf by utilizing the department's
- 6 report all poaching hotline at 1-800-292-7800.
- 7 Enacting section 1. If any federal or state litigation
- 8 overturns the decision to remove gray wolves from the list of
- 9 endangered species, the Michigan department of natural resources
- 10 shall report the impact of that litigation on this act to the
- 11 standing committees of the legislature with jurisdiction over
- 12 issues primarily dealing with natural resources and the
- 13 environment.
