Sec. 202. The appropriations made and the expenditures
authorized under this act and the departments, agencies,
commissions, boards, offices, and programs for which an
appropriation is made under this act are subject to the management
and budget act, 1984 PA 431, MCL 18.1101 to 18.1594.

Sec. 203. The department of natural resources shall require 10 11 local units of government to enter into agreements with the department of natural resources for the purpose of administering 12 the natural resources trust fund grants identified in part 1. Among 13 14 other provisions, the agreements shall require that grant recipients agree to dedicate to public outdoor recreation uses in 15 perpetuity the land acquired or developed; to replace lands 16 17 converted or lost to other than public outdoor recreation use; and, for parcels acquired that are over 5 acres in size, to provide the 18 19 state with a nonparticipating 1/6 minimum royalty interest in any 20 acquired minerals that are retained by the grant recipient. The agreements shall also provide that the full payments of grants can 21 be made only after proof of acquisition, or completion of the 22 23 development project, is submitted by the grant recipient and all 24 costs are verified by the department of natural resources.

25 Sec. 204. Any unobligated balance in a natural resources trust 26 fund appropriation made under section 102 shall not revert to the 27 funds from which appropriated at the close of the fiscal year, but

shall continue until the purpose for which it was appropriated is
 completed for a period not to exceed 3 fiscal years. The unexpended
 balance of any natural resources trust fund appropriation made in
 section 102 remaining after the purpose for which it was
 appropriated is completed shall revert to the Michigan natural
 resources trust fund and be made available for appropriation.
