HOUSE BILL No. 4188

February 1, 2007, Introduced by Reps. Sheltrown, Rick Jones, Gonzales, Mayes, Vagnozzi and Polidori and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1972 PA 382, entitled

"Traxler-McCauley-Law-Bowman bingo act,"

by amending sections 2 and 3 (MCL 432.102 and 432.103), section 2 as amended by 1999 PA 108 and section 3 as amended by 2006 PA 427.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2. (1) "Advertising" means all printed matter, handouts,
- 2 flyers, radio, television, advertising signs, billboards, and other
- 3 media used to promote an event licensed under this act.
- 4 (2) "Bingo" means a game of chance commonly known as bingo in
- 5 which prizes are awarded on the basis of designated numbers or
- 6 symbols conforming to numbers or symbols selected at random.
 - (3) "Bureau" means the bureau of state lottery as created $\frac{by}{c}$
 - IN SECTION 5 OF the McCauley-Traxler-Law-Bowman-McNeely lottery

- 2 (4) "Charity game" means the random resale of a series of
- 3 charity game tickets.
- 4 (5) "Charity game ticket" means a ticket commonly referred to
- 5 as a break open ticket or pull-tab that is approved and acquired by
- 6 the bureau and is distributed and sold by the bureau or a licensed
- 7 supplier to a qualified organization, a portion of which is removed
- 8 to discover whether the ticket is a winning ticket and whether the
- 9 purchaser may be awarded a prize.
- 10 (6) "Commissioner" means the commissioner of state lottery
- 11 THAT TERM as defined by section 3 of the McCauley-Traxler-Law-
- 12 Bowman-McNeely lottery act, 1972 PA 239, MCL 432.3.
- 13 (7) "CONSERVATION DISTRICT" MEANS A CONSERVATION DISTRICT
- 14 ESTABLISHED AND OPERATING UNDER PART 93 OF THE NATURAL RESOURCES
- 15 AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT, 1994 PA 451, MCL 324.9301 TO
- 16 324.9313.
- 17 (8) (7) "Coverall pattern" means a pattern required to win a
- 18 bingo game in which all numbers on a bingo card are required to be
- 19 called.
- Sec. 3. (1) "Educational organization" means an organization
- 21 within this state that is organized not for pecuniary profit, whose
- 22 primary purpose is educational in nature and designed to develop
- 23 the capabilities of individuals by instruction in any public or
- 24 private elementary or secondary school that complies with the
- 25 revised school code, 1976 PA 451, MCL 380.1 to 380.1852, or any
- 26 private or public college or university that is organized not for
- 27 pecuniary profit and that is approved by the state board of

- 1 education.
- 2 (2) "Fraternal organization" means an organization within this
- 3 state, except a college fraternity or sorority, that is organized
- 4 not for pecuniary profit; that is a branch, lodge, or chapter of a
- 5 national or state organization; and that exists for the common
- 6 purpose, brotherhood, or other interests of its members.
- 7 (3) "Licensee" means a person or qualified organization
- 8 licensed under this act.
- 9 (4) "Member" means an individual who qualified for membership
- 10 in a qualified organization under its bylaws, articles of
- 11 incorporation, charter, rules, or other written statement.
- 12 (5) "Person" means a natural person, firm, association,
- 13 corporation, or other legal entity.
- 14 (6) "Qualified organization" means a bona fide religious,
- 15 educational, service, senior citizens, fraternal, or veterans'
- 16 organization that operates without profit to its members and that
- 17 either has been in existence continuously as an organization for a
- 18 period of 5 years or is exempt from taxation under 26 USC 501(c),
- 19 OR A CONSERVATION DISTRICT. Qualified organization does not include
- 20 a candidate committee, political committee, political party
- 21 committee, ballot question committee, independent committee, or any
- 22 other committee as defined by, and organized under, the Michigan
- 23 campaign finance act, 1976 PA 388, MCL 169.201 to 169.282.
- 24 (7) "Religious organization" means any of the following:
- 25 (a) An organization, church, body of communicants, or group
- 26 that is organized not for pecuniary profit and that gathers in
- 27 common membership for mutual support and edification in piety,

- 1 worship, and religious observances.
- 2 (b) A society of individuals that is organized not for
- 3 pecuniary profit and that unites for religious purposes at a
- 4 definite place.
- 5 (c) A church related private school that is organized not for
- 6 pecuniary profit.
- 7 (8) "Senior citizens organization" means an organization
- 8 within this state that is organized not for pecuniary profit, that
- 9 consists of at least 15 members who are 60 years of age or older,
- 10 and that exists for their mutual support and for the advancement of
- 11 the causes of elderly or retired persons.
- 12 (9) "Service organization" means either of the following:
- 13 (a) A branch, lodge, or chapter of a national or state
- 14 organization that is organized not for pecuniary profit and that is
- 15 authorized by its written constitution, charter, articles of
- 16 incorporation, or bylaws to engage in a fraternal, civic, or
- 17 service purpose within the state.
- 18 (b) A local civic organization that is organized not for
- 19 pecuniary profit; that is not affiliated with a state or national
- 20 organization; that is recognized by resolution adopted by the local
- 21 governmental subdivision in which the organization conducts its
- 22 principal activities; whose constitution, charter, articles of
- 23 incorporation, or bylaws contain a provision for the perpetuation
- 24 of the organization as a nonprofit organization; whose entire
- 25 assets are used for charitable purposes; and whose constitution,
- 26 charter, articles of incorporation, or bylaws contain a provision
- 27 that all assets, real property, and personal property shall revert

- 1 to the benefit of the local governmental subdivision that granted
- 2 the resolution upon dissolution of the organization.
- 3 (10) "Veterans' organization" means an organization within
- 4 this state, or a branch, lodge, or chapter within this state of a
- 5 state organization or of a national organization chartered by the
- 6 congress of the United States, that is organized not for pecuniary
- 7 profit, the membership of which consists of individuals who were
- 8 members of the armed services or forces of the United States.
