## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 37A. (1) BEFORE A PRISONER IS RELEASED ON PAROLE OR
- 2 DISCHARGED WITHOUT BEING PAROLED, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REQUIRE THE
- 3 PRISONER TO UNDERGO A TEST FOR HIV OR AN ANTIBODY TO HIV. THE TEST
- 4 SHALL OCCUR NOT EARLIER THAN 60 DAYS BEFORE THE PRISONER IS PAROLED
- 5 OR DISCHARGED.
- 6 (2) IF A PRISONER RECEIVES A POSITIVE TEST RESULT FOR HIV OR
- 7 AN ANTIBODY TO HIV, BOTH OF THE FOLLOWING APPLY:
- 8 (A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REPORT THE POSITIVE TEST RESULT TO
- 9 THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY HEALTH, IN COMPLIANCE WITH SECTION 5114
- 10 OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH CODE, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.5114.
