A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled
"The revised school code,"
(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding section 1164.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 1164. IF A SCHOOL DISTRICT OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY
2 TEACHES AFRICAN HISTORY IN AN ELEMENTARY GRADE, THE BOARD OF THE
3 SCHOOL DISTRICT OR BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY
4 SHALL ENSURE THAT THE CONTENT OF THE INSTRUCTION IS FOCUSED ON 1 OR
5 MORE OF THE FOLLOWING KINGDOMS: GHANA, MALI, SONGHAY, BENIN, BORNU,
6 NUBIA, AXUM, MEROE, MEDIEVAL ETHIOPIA, OR THE SWAHILI COAST.
