June 28, 2007, Introduced by Rep. Farrah and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled "Michigan liquor control code of 1998," by amending section 503 (MCL 436.1503).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 503. (1) A—THE COMMISSION SHALL DENY A new application
- 2 for a license to sell alcoholic beverages LIQUOR at retail, or a
- 3 request to transfer location of an existing license, shall be
- 4 denied—if the contemplated location is within 500 feet of a church
- 5 or a school building. The distance between the church or school
