Sec. 375. After the expiration of 5 years after the initial

3 (b) Effective on the next January 1 occurring at least 1 year 4 after the question under section 410 is presented to the school 5 electors, the powers of the school reform board established for the qualifying school district under this part, of the chief executive 6 officer appointed under this part, and of all other officers 7 appointed under this part cease. This subdivision does not prohibit 8 9 the chief executive officer from serving as the interim chief 10 executive officer under section 420, and does not prohibit the 11 chief executive officer from retaining an officer or employee 12 appointed or hired by the chief executive officer.

13 (c) Effective on the next January 1 occurring at least 1 year 14 after the question under section 410 is presented to the school 15 electors, the provisions of this part do not apply to that 16 qualifying school district.

(D) WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER THE NEXT JANUARY 1 OCCURRING AT LEAST
18 1 YEAR AFTER THE QUESTION UNDER SECTION 410 IS PRESENTED TO THE
19 SCHOOL ELECTORS, THE STATE BOARD SHALL CONDUCT OR ARRANGE FOR A
20 FORENSIC AUDIT OF THE QUALIFYING SCHOOL DISTRICT'S OPERATIONS AND
21 RECORDS. AS USED IN THIS SECTION, "FORENSIC AUDIT" MEANS AN AUDIT
22 THAT IS DESIGNED TO DETERMINE WHETHER THERE HAS BEEN ANY VIOLATION
23 OF LAW OR OF GENERALLY ACCEPTED GOVERNMENTAL ACCOUNTING PRACTICES.
