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HOUSE BILL No. 5264

September 25, 2007, Introduced by Rep. Young and referred to the Committee on Commerce.

A bill to create the Michigan job training corps; to encourage employment-related educational opportunities for youth; to provide for participation by certain employers; to prescribe the powers and duties of certain departments; to establish a fund and provide for the administration of that fund; and to make an appropriation.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
 "Michigan job training corps act".
- 3 Sec. 2. As used in this act:
 - (a) "Department" means the department of labor and economic growth.
 - (b) "Employer" means a person who obtains the services of 1 or more individuals in exchange for consideration and retains control and supervision of those individuals in the performance of those individuals' services.

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- 1 Sec. 3. Within 90 days after the effective date of this act,
- 2 the department shall develop and implement a statewide program to
- 3 encourage employer participation in the employment and training of
- 4 individuals between the ages of 16 and 18 years. The program shall
- 5 be known as the "Michigan job training corps".
- 6 Sec. 4. An employer may participate in the Michigan job
- 7 training corps program by applying to the department for
- 8 designation as a Michigan job training corps employer. The
- 9 application shall be in writing, identify the employer, and state
- 10 all of the following:
- 11 (a) That the employer contractually agrees to provide part-
- 12 time or seasonal employment, or a combination of part-time and
- 13 seasonal employment, to 1 or more individuals between the ages of
- **14** 16 and 18.
- 15 (b) That the employment described in subdivision (a) includes
- 16 or shall include on-the-job training and employment orientation for
- 17 employees described in subdivision (a) who seek to pursue areas of
- 18 study related to the particular employment.
- 19 (c) That the employer contractually agrees to fund all or a
- 20 portion of the higher education costs of those individuals
- 21 described in subdivision (b) who pursue advanced higher education.
- Sec. 5. An employer designated by the department as a Michigan
- 23 job training corps employer who provides funding for all or a
- 24 portion of the higher education costs of an employee hired or
- 25 retained under this act is entitled to reimbursement of that
- 26 funding from the Michigan job training corps fund created in
- 27 section 6.

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- 1 Sec. 6. (1) The Michigan job training corps fund is created
- 2 within the state treasury.
- 3 (2) The state treasurer may receive money or other assets from
- 4 any source for deposit into the fund. The state treasurer shall
- 5 direct the investment of the fund. The state treasurer shall credit
- 6 to the fund interest and earnings from fund investments.
- 7 (3) Money in the fund at the close of the fiscal year shall
- 8 remain in the fund and shall not lapse to the general fund.
- 9 (4) The department of labor and economic growth shall be the
- 10 administrator of the fund for auditing purposes.
- 11 (5) The department of labor and economic growth shall expend
- 12 money from the fund, upon appropriation, only for the purpose of
- 13 reimbursing employers for higher education funding provided under
- 14 section 5.
- 15 Sec. 7. The sum of \$1,000,000.00 is appropriated from the
- 16 general fund to the Michigan job training corps fund created in
- 17 section 6.
