- 1 Sec. 1177a. (1) If, at the beginning of a school year, the

- 3 academy provides information on immunizations, infectious disease,
- 4 medications, or other school health issues to parents and quardians
- 5 of pupils in at least grades 6, 9, and 12, then with that
- 6 information the board or board of directors shall include
- 7 information about meningococcal meningitis and the vaccine for
- 8 meningococcal meningitis. The information shall include at least
- the causes and symptoms of meningococcal meningitis, how it is
- 10 spread, and sources where parents and quardians may obtain

- 1 additional information about meningococcal meningitis and may
