Sec. 239. (1) An insurance company shall be allowed a credit
 against the tax imposed under this chapter in an amount equal to
 50% of the examination fees paid by the insurance company during
 the tax year pursuant to section 224 of the insurance code of 1956,
 1956 PA 218, MCL 500.224.

6 (2) An insurance company that does not make any of the
7 payments described under section 237(1)(a) through (d) may claim a
8 credit against the tax imposed under this act as provided under
9 section 403(2). , not to exceed 65% of the insurance company's tax
