## **HOUSE BILL No. 5337**

October 23, 2007, Introduced by Rep. David Law and referred to the Committee on Oversight and Investigations.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled

"Michigan election law,"

by amending section 509q (MCL 168.509q), as amended by 2005 PA 71, and by adding section 496a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 496A. (1) VOTER REGISTRATION APPLICATIONS SHALL CONTAIN A
- 2 STATEMENT REQUIRING AN APPLICANT TO SUBMIT SATISFACTORY EVIDENCE OF
- 3 UNITED STATES CITIZENSHIP WITH HIS OR HER APPLICATION AND STATING
- 4 THAT THE APPLICATION SHALL BE REJECTED IF SATISFACTORY EVIDENCE OF
- 5 UNITED STATES CITIZENSHIP IS NOT PROVIDED.
- 6 (2) A PERSON PROCESSING VOTER REGISTRATION APPLICATIONS AT A
- 7 DEPARTMENT OF STATE OFFICE, A DESIGNATED VOTER REGISTRATION AGENCY,
  - OR A COUNTY, CITY, TOWNSHIP, OR VILLAGE CLERK'S OFFICE SHALL REJECT

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- 1 A VOTER REGISTRATION APPLICATION THAT IS NOT ACCOMPANIED BY
- 2 SATISFACTORY EVIDENCE OF UNITED STATES CITIZENSHIP. SATISFACTORY
- 3 EVIDENCE OF UNITED STATES CITIZENSHIP INCLUDES ANY OF THE
- 4 FOLLOWING:
- 5 (A) THE APPLICANT'S DRIVER LICENSE NUMBER OR PERSONAL
- 6 IDENTIFICATION CARD NUMBER ISSUED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE OR THE
- 7 EQUIVALENT DEPARTMENT OF ANOTHER STATE IF THAT DEPARTMENT INDICATES
- 8 ON THE APPLICANT'S DRIVER LICENSE OR PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION CARD
- 9 THAT THE PERSON HAS PROVIDED SATISFACTORY EVIDENCE OF UNITED STATES
- 10 CITIZENSHIP.
- 11 (B) A LEGIBLE PHOTOCOPY OF THE APPLICANT'S BIRTH CERTIFICATE
- 12 THAT VERIFIES UNITED STATES CITIZENSHIP TO THE SATISFACTION OF THE
- 13 PERSON PROCESSING THE VOTER REGISTRATION APPLICATION.
- 14 (C) THE APPLICANT'S UNITED STATES PASSPORT.
- 15 (D) A LEGIBLE PHOTOCOPY OF THE PERTINENT PAGES OF THE
- 16 APPLICANT'S UNITED STATES PASSPORT IDENTIFYING THE APPLICANT AND
- 17 THE APPLICANT'S PASSPORT NUMBER.
- 18 (E) THE APPLICANT'S UNITED STATES NATURALIZATION DOCUMENTS OR
- 19 THE NUMBER OF THE CERTIFICATE OF NATURALIZATION. IF ONLY THE NUMBER
- 20 OF THE CERTIFICATE OF NATURALIZATION IS PROVIDED, THE APPLICANT
- 21 SHALL NOT BE INCLUDED IN THE REGISTRATION ROLLS AND QUALIFIED VOTER
- 22 FILE UNTIL THE PERSON PROCESSING THE APPLICATION VERIFIES THE
- 23 NUMBER OF THE CERTIFICATE OF NATURALIZATION WITH THE UNITED STATES
- 24 IMMIGRATION AND NATURALIZATION SERVICE.
- 25 (F) OTHER DOCUMENTS OR METHODS OF PROOF THAT ARE USED TO
- 26 ESTABLISH UNITED STATES CITIZENSHIP PURSUANT TO THE IMMIGRATION
- 27 REFORM AND CONTROL ACT OF 1986, PUBLIC LAW 99-603, 100 STAT. 3359.

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- 1 (G) THE APPLICANT'S BUREAU OF INDIAN AFFAIRS CARD NUMBER,
- 2 TRIBAL TREATY CARD NUMBER, OR TRIBAL ENROLLMENT NUMBER.
- 3 (3) FOR PURPOSES OF THIS SECTION, PROOF OF VOTER REGISTRATION
- 4 FROM ANOTHER STATE IS NOT SATISFACTORY EVIDENCE OF UNITED STATES
- 5 CITIZENSHIP.
- 6 (4) NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (2), A PERSON WHO IS REGISTERED
- 7 TO VOTE IN THIS STATE ON THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AMENDATORY ACT
- 8 THAT ADDED THIS SECTION SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED TO SUBMIT EVIDENCE OF
- 9 UNITED STATES CITIZENSHIP UNLESS THE PERSON MOVES HIS OR HER
- 10 RESIDENCE TO ANOTHER CITY, TOWNSHIP, OR VILLAGE.
- 11 (5) AFTER A PERSON SUBMITS SATISFACTORY EVIDENCE OF
- 12 CITIZENSHIP, THE CITY, TOWNSHIP, OR VILLAGE CLERK SHALL ADD THIS
- 13 INFORMATION TO THE QUALIFIED VOTER FILE. THE CITY, TOWNSHIP, OR
- 14 VILLAGE CLERK MAY DESTROY ALL DOCUMENTS SUBMITTED AS EVIDENCE OF
- 15 UNITED STATES CITIZENSHIP NOT LESS THAN 2 YEARS AFTER THE DATE OF
- 16 SUBMISSION.
- 17 Sec. 509q. The qualified voter file shall contain all of the
- 18 following information for each qualified voter:
- 19 (a) The name; residence address including house number and
- 20 street name or rural route and box number, and the apartment
- 21 number, if any; city; state; zip code; and date of birth.
- (b) The driver's license number or state personal
- 23 identification card number or similar number issued by a designated
- 24 voter registration agency.
- 25 (c) Jurisdictional information including county and city or
- 26 township; village, if any; and school district.
- 27 (d) Precinct numbers and ward numbers, if any.

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- 1 (e) Any other information that the secretary of state
- 2 determines is necessary to assess the eligibility of qualified
- 3 electors or to administer voter registration or other aspects of
- 4 the election process.
- 5 (f) Voting history for a 5-year period.
- 6 (g) The most recent digitized signature of an elector if
- 7 captured or reproduced by the secretary of state or a county, city,
- 8 or township clerk from a voter registration application pursuant to
- 9 section 509hh, or captured or reproduced by the secretary of state
- 10 pursuant to section 307 of the Michigan vehicle code, 1949 PA 300,

- 12 (H) EVIDENCE OF UNITED STATES CITIZENSHIP.

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
