THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 423A. (1) AN OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE OF THE EXECUTIVE
- 2 DEPARTMENT OF THIS STATE WHO INTENTIONALLY PROVIDES INFORMATION
- 3 THAT HE OR SHE KNOWS IS FALSE OR MISLEADING TO ANY COMMITTEE OR
- 4 SUBCOMMITTEE OF THE LEGISLATURE OF THIS STATE IS GUILTY OF PERJURY
- 5 PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 15 YEARS.
 - (2) SUBSECTION (1) APPLIES REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THE
- 7 INFORMATION IS PROVIDED UNDER OATH.
