## HOUSE BILL No. 5910

March 19, 2008, Introduced by Reps. Dean, Corriveau, Clack, Hopgood, Brown, Valentine, Accavitti and Lemmons and referred to the Committee on Families and Children's Services.

A bill to amend 1975 PA 238, entitled

"Child protection law,"

by amending section 7j (MCL 722.627j), as amended by 2004 PA 563.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 7j. (1) Upon written request, the department may provide 2 to an individual documentation stating that the individual is not 3 named in a central registry case as the perpetrator of child abuse 4 or child neglect. The written request required under this section 5 shall include the individual's affirmation that he or she is employed by, volunteers at, is applying for employment in, or is 6 7 seeking to volunteer in a child care center, child caring institution, or child placing agency. 8

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(2) For the purpose of applying for employment or seeking to

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volunteer in a child care center, child caring institution, or 1 2 child placing agency, an AN individual may share, OR DIRECT THE DEPARTMENT TO SHARE, the document provided in subsection (1) with 3 4 the child care center owner or licensee, or a child caring institution or child placing agency, or an individual authorized by 5 the child care center owner or licensee, the child caring 6 7 institution, or the child placing agency WHOEVER IS APPROPRIATE FOR THE PURPOSE OF SEEKING EMPLOYMENT OR SERVING AS A VOLUNTEER. 8

9 (3) The family independence agency **DEPARTMENT** may develop an automated system that will allow an individual applying for child-10 11 related employment or seeking to volunteer in a capacity that would 12 allow unsupervised access to a child for whom the individual is not a person responsible for that child's health or welfare to be 13 listed in that system if a screening of the individual finds that 14 he or she has not been named in a central registry case as the 15 perpetrator of child abuse or child neglect. The automated system 16 17 developed under this section shall provide for public access to the list of individuals who have been screened for the purposes of 18 19 complying with this section. An automated system developed under 20 this section shall have appropriate safeguards and procedures to ensure that information that is confidential under this act, state 21 22 law, or federal law is not accessible or disclosed through that 23 system.

(4) As used in this section, "child care center", "child
caring institution", and "child placing agency" mean those terms as
defined in section 1 of 1973 PA 116, MCL 722.111.

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
