## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1	PART 101A
2	COMMERCIAL DISPLAY OF HUMAN REMAINS
3	SEC. 10151. (1) AS USED IN THIS PART:
4	(A) "COMMERCIAL PURPOSES" MEANS EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING:
5	(i) A DISPLAY FOR WHICH THE PUBLIC IS CHARGED A FEE OR OTHER
6	CONSIDERATION AS A CONDITION OF VIEWING.
7	(ii) a display for which an exhibitor accepts payment or oth

(B) "EXHIBITOR" MEANS A PERSON WHO SHOWS OR PUTS ON, OR

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- 1 CONTRACTS TO SHOW OR PUT ON, A TEMPORARY PUBLIC DISPLAY OF HUMAN
- 2 REMAINS.
- 3 (C) "LOCAL GOVERNING ENTITY" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN
- 4 SECTION 2406.
- 5 (D) "MUSEUM FACILITY" MEANS A PUBLIC OR PRIVATE NONPROFIT
- 6 INSTITUTION THAT MEETS ALL OF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:
- 7 (i) IS ACCREDITED BY THE AMERICAN ASSOCIATION OF MUSEUMS OR IS
- 8 A PART OF AN ACCREDITED COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY.
- 9 (ii) IS ORGANIZED ON A PERMANENT BASIS FOR ESSENTIALLY
- 10 EDUCATIONAL OR AESTHETIC PURPOSES.
- 11 (iii) OWNS OR USES, CARES FOR, AND EXHIBITS TANGIBLE OBJECTS TO
- 12 THE GENERAL PUBLIC ON A REGULAR BASIS.
- 13 (2) IN ADDITION, ARTICLE 1 CONTAINS GENERAL DEFINITIONS AND
- 14 PRINCIPLES OF CONSTRUCTION APPLICABLE TO ALL ARTICLES OF THIS ACT.
- 15 SEC. 10152. (1) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS PART, A
- 16 PERSON SHALL NOT DISPLAY HUMAN REMAINS FOR COMMERCIAL PURPOSES OR
- 17 MEDICAL EDUCATION PURPOSES. A PERSON MAY DISPLAY HUMAN REMAINS FOR
- 18 COMMERCIAL PURPOSES OR MEDICAL EDUCATION PURPOSES IF THE LOCAL
- 19 GOVERNING ENTITY OF THE LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY,
- 20 COUNTY, OR DISTRICT IN WHICH THE HUMAN REMAINS WILL BE DISPLAYED
- 21 HAS ESTABLISHED A PERMIT PROGRAM AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 10153 AND
- 22 THE PERSON OBTAINS A PERMIT FROM THE APPROPRIATE LOCAL HEALTH
- 23 DEPARTMENT FOR THAT DISPLAY.
- 24 (2) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO A DISPLAY OF HUMAN REMAINS
- 25 THAT MEETS ANY OF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:
- 26 (A) CONSISTS OF HUMAN REMAINS THAT ARE MORE THAN 100 YEARS
- 27 OLD.

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- 1 (B) CONSISTS SOLELY OF HUMAN TEETH OR HAIR.
- 2 (C) IS PART OF THE ORDINARY DISPLAY OR VIEWING OF THE DECEASED
- 3 AT A FUNERAL ESTABLISHMENT OR IS PART OF A SIMILAR FUNERAL OR
- 4 MEMORIAL SERVICE.
- 5 (D) CONSISTS SOLELY OF OBJECTS OF RELIGIOUS VENERATION.
- 6 (E) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SUBDIVISION, IS IN
- 7 THE POSSESSION OF A MUSEUM FACILITY. HOWEVER, IF THE MUSEUM
- 8 FACILITY PAID OR OFFERED OTHER CONSIDERATION TO AN EXHIBITOR TO
- 9 DISPLAY HUMAN REMAINS AND THAT DISPLAY IS NOT EXEMPT FROM THIS PART
- 10 UNDER SUBDIVISIONS (A) TO (D), THE EXHIBITOR SHALL NOT DISPLAY THE
- 11 HUMAN REMAINS UNLESS THE LOCAL GOVERNING ENTITY OF THE CITY,
- 12 COUNTY, OR DISTRICT IN WHICH THE MUSEUM FACILITY IS LOCATED HAS
- 13 ESTABLISHED A PERMIT PROGRAM AS DESCRIBED IN SECTION 10153 AND THE
- 14 MUSEUM FACILITY OBTAINS A PERMIT FROM THE APPROPRIATE LOCAL HEALTH
- 15 DEPARTMENT FOR THAT DISPLAY.
- 16 (3) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT TO A CIVIL
- 17 PENALTY OF AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$10,000.00 FOR EACH VIOLATION.
- 18 SEC. 10153. (1) A LOCAL GOVERNING ENTITY MAY ESTABLISH A
- 19 PERMIT PROGRAM UNDER THIS PART TO ALLOW THE DISPLAY OF HUMAN
- 20 REMAINS FOR COMMERCIAL PURPOSES OR MEDICAL EDUCATION PURPOSES UNDER
- 21 CERTAIN CIRCUMSTANCES. IF ESTABLISHED, THE LOCAL GOVERNING ENTITY
- 22 SHALL AUTHORIZE THE LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT TO IMPLEMENT,
- 23 ADMINISTER, AND ENFORCE THE PERMIT PROGRAM UNDER THIS SECTION. THE
- 24 LOCAL GOVERNING ENTITY SHALL ESTABLISH THE STANDARDS AND
- 25 REQUIREMENTS OF THE PERMIT PROGRAM. A LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT SHALL
- 26 ONLY ISSUE A PERMIT TO A PERSON FOR THE DISPLAY OF HUMAN REMAINS TO
- 27 THE PUBLIC FOR COMMERCIAL PURPOSES OR MEDICAL EDUCATION PURPOSES IF

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- 1 THE LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT, THE LOCAL PUBLIC HEALTH OFFICIAL, OR
- 2 HIS OR HER DESIGNEE DETERMINES THAT ALL OF THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE
- 3 PERMIT PROGRAM HAVE BEEN MET AND THAT THE PERSON HAS PROVIDED VALID
- 4 WRITTEN AUTHORIZATION TO DISPLAY THE HUMAN REMAINS FOR COMMERCIAL
- 5 PURPOSES OR MEDICAL EDUCATION PURPOSES FROM ANY OF THE FOLLOWING
- 6 WITH REGARD TO EACH HUMAN WHOSE REMAINS ARE ON DISPLAY:
- 7 (A) THE DECEDENT, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, AUTHORIZATION
- 8 GIVEN BY WILL.
- 9 (B) A PERSON AUTHORIZED TO MAKE AN ANATOMICAL GIFT UNDER PART
- 10 101 OR IN ACCORD WITH THE ANATOMICAL GIFT LAWS OF ANOTHER STATE OR
- 11 FOREIGN COUNTRY.
- 12 (2) IF THE LOCAL GOVERNING ENTITY OF A LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT
- 13 ESTABLISHES A PERMIT PROGRAM UNDER SUBSECTION (1), THE LOCAL HEALTH
- 14 DEPARTMENT SHALL ENFORCE THIS PART AND ANY RULES PROMULGATED UNDER
- 15 THIS PART PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 2461(2) AND 2462. IN ADDITION TO THE
- 16 PENALTIES AND REMEDIES UNDER THIS PART, A LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT
- 17 MAY ENFORCE THIS PART AND ANY RULES PROMULGATED UNDER THIS PART
- 18 THROUGH AN ACTION COMMENCED PURSUANT TO SECTION 2465 OR ANY OTHER
- 19 APPROPRIATE ACTION AUTHORIZED BY LAW.
- 20 SEC. 10154. THIS PART DOES NOT APPLY TO THE UTILIZATION OF
- 21 HUMAN REMAINS IN A MANNER THAT MEETS THE PURPOSES OF AND COMPLIES
- 22 WITH PART 101.
