"Public health code,"

by amending section 21771 (MCL 333.21771).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 21771. (1) A licensee, nursing home administrator, or
 employee of a nursing home shall not physically, mentally, or
 emotionally abuse, mistreat, or harmfully neglect a patient.

4 (2) A nursing home employee who becomes aware of an act
5 prohibited by this section immediately shall report the matter to
6 the nursing home administrator, or nursing director, OR DEPARTMENT.
7 A nursing home administrator or nursing director who becomes aware
8 of an act prohibited by this section immediately shall report the
9 matter by telephone to the department. of public health, which in

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turn UPON RECEIPT OF A REPORT UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, THE DEPARTMENT
 shall notify the department of social HUMAN services.

3 (3) Any person may report a violation of this section to the4 department.

5 (4) A physician or other licensed health care personnel of a
6 hospital or other health care facility to which a patient is
7 transferred who becomes aware of an act prohibited by this section
8 shall report the act to the department.

9 (5) Upon receipt of a report made under this section, the
10 department shall make an investigation. The department may require
11 the person making the report to submit a written report or to
12 supply additional information, or both.

13 (6) A licensee or nursing home administrator shall not evict,
14 harass, dismiss, or retaliate against a patient, a patient's
15 representative, or an employee who makes a report under this
16 section.

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
