- 2 NEGLECTS OR REFUSES TO FILE A REPORT UNDER SECTION 17790 IS SUBJECT
- 3 TO AN ADMINISTRATIVE FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$10,000.00. A
- 4 MANUFACTURER OR WHOLESALE DISTRIBUTOR WHO INTENTIONALLY PROVIDES A
- 5 FALSE REPORT UNDER SECTION 17790 IS SUBJECT TO AN ADMINISTRATIVE
- FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500,000.00.
- 7 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
- 8 unless Senate Bill No. or House Bill No. 6158 (request no.
- 9 07254'08) of the 94th Legislature is enacted into law.
