HOUSE BILL No. 6290

June 27, 2008, Introduced by Rep. Hildenbrand and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1998 PA 386, entitled "Estates and protected individuals code," by amending section 3719 (MCL 700.3719).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 3719. (1) A personal representative is entitled to reasonable compensation for services performed. A personal representative may pay the personal representative's own compensation periodically as earned without prior court approval.
 - (2) If an attorney serves as personal representative, the attorney shall maintain time records that state the identity of the person performing personal representative services, the date the services are performed, the amount of time expended in performing the services, and a brief description of the services.
