- 7 Sec. 2. A person shall not use a rope, chain, wire, or similar device as a barrier to prevent access to land unless both of the 8 following conditions are met: 9

(a) The rope, chain, wire, or similar device is enclosed in

1 material that is the color hunter orange.

2 (b) The rope, chain, wire, or similar device is not more than3 30 inches above the ground at any point.

Sec. 3. A person who violates this act is responsible for a
state civil infraction and may be ordered to pay a civil fine of
not more than \$250.00.
