

SENATE BILL No. 152

February 1, 2007, Introduced by Senators BRATER, SCHAUER, JACOBS, WHITMER, GLEASON, OLSHOVE, BASHAM and PRUSI and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources and Environmental Affairs.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled
"Natural resources and environmental protection act,"
by amending section 3902 (MCL 324.3902).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 3902. (1) ~~A—EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (2) OR~~
2 OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY RULE, A person shall not sell, OFFER FOR
3 SALE, or distribute for SALE OR use in this state a cleaning agent
4 that contains phosphorus in any form in excess of 8.7% by weight
5 expressed as elemental phosphorus.

6 (2) A PERSON SHALL NOT SELL, OFFER FOR SALE, OR DISTRIBUTE FOR
7 SALE OR USE IN THIS STATE EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING CLEANING AGENTS
8 IF THEY CONTAIN PHOSPHORUS IN ANY FORM IN EXCESS OF 0.5% BY WEIGHT
9 EXPRESSED AS ELEMENTAL PHOSPHORUS:

1 (A) A CLEANING AGENT INTENDED FOR USE IN HOUSEHOLD
2 DISHWASHERS.

3 (B) A CLEANING AGENT THAT IS INTENDED FOR USE WITH DETERGENT
4 IN HOUSEHOLD CLOTHES WASHING MACHINES.
