THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 3902. (1) A-EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (2) OR
- 2 OTHERWISE PROVIDED BY RULE, A person shall not sell, OFFER FOR
- 3 SALE, or distribute for SALE OR use in this state a cleaning agent
- 4 that contains phosphorus in any form in excess of 8.7% by weight
- 5 expressed as elemental phosphorus.
- 6 (2) A PERSON SHALL NOT SELL, OFFER FOR SALE, OR DISTRIBUTE FOR
- 7 SALE OR USE IN THIS STATE EITHER OF THE FOLLOWING CLEANING AGENTS
- 8 IF THEY CONTAIN PHOSPHORUS IN ANY FORM IN EXCESS OF 0.5% BY WEIGHT
- 9 EXPRESSED AS ELEMENTAL PHOSPHORUS:
