SENATE BILL No. 430

April 24, 2007, Introduced by Senators BIRKHOLZ, McMANUS, PRUSI and ALLEN and referred to the Committee on Natural Resources and Environmental Affairs.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled "Natural resources and environmental protection act," (MCL 324.101 to 324.90106) by adding section 74130.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 74130. (1) THE GREAT LAKES STATE PARK PRESERVATION FUND 2 IS CREATED WITHIN THE STATE TREASURY.

(2) THE STATE TREASURER MAY RECEIVE MONEY OR OTHER ASSETS FROM 3 4 ANY SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT INTO THE GREAT LAKES STATE PARK PRESERVATION 5 FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DIRECT THE INVESTMENT OF THE GREAT 6 LAKES STATE PARK PRESERVATION FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL 7 CREDIT TO THE GREAT LAKES STATE PARK PRESERVATION FUND INTEREST AND EARNINGS FROM FUND INVESTMENTS. 8 9

(3) MONEY IN THE GREAT LAKES STATE PARK PRESERVATION FUND AT

1 THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR SHALL REMAIN IN THE FUND AND SHALL NOT 2 LAPSE TO THE GENERAL FUND.

4 STATE PARK PRESERVATION FUND, UPON APPROPRIATION, ONLY FOR 1 OR

 OPPORTUNITIES.

13 (E) INTENTIONAL SINKING OF VESSELS.

14 (F) TOURISM RESEARCH AND MARKETING.

15 (G) HERITAGE EDUCATION.

16 (H) LAW ENFORCEMENT.
