THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 2975A. UPON ENTRY OF A JUDGMENT FOR DAMAGES AGAINST A 2 LICENSEE UNDER ARTICLE 24 OF THE OCCUPATIONAL CODE, 1980 PA 299, 3 MCL 339.2401 TO 339.2412, ON THE BASIS OF A VIOLATION OF SECTION 4 2411(2) OF THE OCCUPATIONAL CODE, 1980 PA 299, MCL 339.2411, THE 5 COURT SHALL NOTIFY THE BUREAU OF COMMERCIAL SERVICES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND ECONOMIC GROWTH OF THE ENTRY OF THAT 6 7 JUDGMENT AND SHALL CONVEY TO THE DEPARTMENT A COPY OF THAT 8 JUDGMENT.

(e) "Security interest" means any interest in real or personalproperty that secures payment or performance of an obligation.

(f) "Substituted proceeds of a crime" means any property
obtained or any gain realized by the sale or exchange of proceeds
of a crime.
