 - (b) "Urban area" means an urbanized area as determined by the economics and statistics administration, United States bureau of the census, according to the most recent federal decennial census.
 - Sec. 2. The department of labor and economic growth shall establish a jobs information system that provides individuals residing in each urban area in this state with employment
