SENATE BILL No. 647

July 24, 2007, Introduced by Senator KUIPERS and referred to the Committee on Local, Urban and State Affairs.

A bill to require a local unit of government to post notice on every highway or street leading into the local unit of government if the local unit of government charges a fee to nonresidents of the local unit of government for providing emergency response services at motor vehicle accidents; and to provide for penalties.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "emergency response services fee notice act".
 - Sec. 3. As used in this act:
- (a) "Emergency response services" means police department services, fire department services, or emergency medical services.
- (b) "Fee" means the cost charged by a local unit of government for providing emergency response services at a motor vehicle
