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## **SENATE BILL No. 1395**

June 17, 2008, Introduced by Senators JELINEK, PAPPAGEORGE, GARCIA and BROWN and referred to the Committee on Commerce and Tourism.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 451, entitled
"Natural resources and environmental protection act,"
by amending section 20113 (MCL 324.20113), as amended by 1996 PA
383.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 20113. (1) Money required to implement the programs

described under this part and to pay for response activities

recommended under this part shall be appropriated from the fund and

any other source the legislature considers necessary to implement

the requirements of this part.

(2) Money from the fund shall be appropriated only for response activities at sites that have been subjected to the risk

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- 1 assessment process described in section 20105.
- 2 (3) The department shall annually submit to the governor a
- 3 request for appropriation from the fund. The request will include a
- 4 lump sum amount for the purposes of subsection (4)(a) and a lump
- 5 sum amount for the purposes of subsection (4)(f). For the purposes
- 6 set forth in subsection (4)(b), (c), (d), and (e), the request
- 7 shall include a list of sites where the department is proposing to
- 8 expend funds. The FOR EACH SITE, THE list shall include the
- 9 following information for each site: the SITE'S common name, of the
- 10 site, the response activities that are planned to be conducted, and
- 11 the estimated amount of money that is needed to conduct the
- 12 response activities. The legislature shall approve by law the list
- 13 of sites to be addressed and shall provide a lump sum appropriation
- 14 for these sites based on the total estimated amount needed for the
- 15 approved sites.
- 16 (4) Money from the fund may be used, upon appropriation, for
- 17 the following as determined by the department:
- 18 (a) National priority list municipal landfill cost-share
- 19 grants to be approved by the board pursuant to section 20109a.
- 20 (b) Superfund match, which includes funding for any response
- 21 activity that is required to match federal dollars at a superfund
- 22 site as required under the comprehensive environmental response,
- 23 compensation, and liability act of 1980, Public Law 96-510. 7 94
- 24 Stat. 2767.
- 25 (c) Response activities to address actual or potential public
- 26 health or environmental problems.
- 27 (d) Completion of response activities initiated by the THIS

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- 1 state using environmental protection bond funds or completion of
- 2 response activities at facilities initiated by a person who was
- 3 liable under this part prior to Public Act 71 BEFORE THE EFFECTIVE
- 4 DATE of 1995 PA 71 but is not liable under section 20126, of this
- 5 part, where such response activities have ceased.
- 6 (e) Response activities at sites that will facilitate
- 7 redevelopment.
- 8 (f) Emergency response actions for sites to be determined by
- 9 the department.
- 10 (G) GRANTS FOR 1 OR MORE OF THE FOLLOWING PURPOSES:
- 11 (i) RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT OF NEW TECHNOLOGIES FOR DEALERS TO
- 12 PROCESS RETURNABLE CONTAINERS UNDER 1976 IL 1, MCL 445.571 TO
- 13 445.576.
- 14 (ii) RETROFITTING REVERSE VENDING MACHINES TO ACCOMMODATE
- 15 TECHNOLOGIES DESCRIBED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (i).
- 16 (5) Money in the fund shall be expended first for the purposes
- 17 described in subsection (4)(b) and (f) and health or environmental
- 18 problems under subsection (4)(c) that are related to acute health
- 19 or environmental problems. Following these expenditures, not less
- 20 than 50% of the remaining money expended under this section shall
- 21 be expended for response activities that facilitate redevelopment
- 22 of urbanized areas. All additional expenditures under this section
- 23 shall be expended following the expenditures described in this
- 24 subsection. As used in this subsection, "urbanized area" means an
- 25 urbanized area as determined by the economics and statistics
- 26 administration, United States bureau of census, according to the
- 27 1990 2000 census.

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- 1 (6) The total amount of funds expended by the department for
- 2 national priority list municipal landfill cost-share grants IN A
- 3 FISCAL YEAR shall not exceed the lesser of 12% of the funds
- 4 appropriated from the fund in a FOR THAT fiscal year or
- 5 \$6,000,000.00. in a fiscal year.
- 6 (7) Not later than December 31 of each year, the department
- 7 shall provide to the governor, the senate and house of
- 8 representatives standing committees with jurisdiction over issues
- 9 pertaining to natural resources and the environment, and the senate
- 10 and house of representatives appropriations committees a list of
- 11 all projects financed under this part through the preceding fiscal
- 12 year. The list shall include the project site and location, the
- 13 nature of the project, the total amount of money authorized, the
- 14 total amount of money expended, and project status.
