

SENATE BILL No. 1464

September 10, 2008, Introduced by Senators SWITALSKI and JELINEK and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled
"Michigan vehicle code,"
by amending section 809 (MCL 257.809), as amended by 2007 PA 71.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 809. (1) An application for transfer of registration from
2 a vehicle subject to section 801(1)(a) to another vehicle subject
3 to that section shall be accompanied by a fee of \$8.00. In addition
4 to the fee of \$8.00, if the registration is transferred from a
5 passenger vehicle to a motor home and if the registration fee for
6 the motor home is greater than the fee paid upon registration of
7 the vehicle from which the registration was removed, then the
8 difference in fee shall be paid by the applicant. If the fee is
9 less than that paid for the registration of the vehicle from which
10 the plates were removed, the difference shall not be refunded. The

1 fees required by this subsection shall be considered to include all
2 fees or charges imposed by this act for the transfer of
3 registration, except those which may be assessed under section 234.

4 (2) An application for a transfer of registration, other than
5 a transfer described in subsection (1), shall be accompanied by a
6 fee of \$8.00. In addition to the fee of \$8.00, if the registration
7 plates are transferred to another vehicle, as provided in section
8 233, and if the plate fee for a 12-month registration for the
9 vehicle to which the registration is transferred is greater than
10 the plate fee paid upon registration of the vehicle from which the
11 registration was removed, then the difference shall be paid by the
12 applicant for the new registration. If the fee is less than that
13 paid for registration of the vehicle from which the registration
14 was removed, the difference shall not be refunded.

15 (3) A transfer of registration fee collected under this
16 section on and after October 1, 2004 through September 30, ~~2008~~
17 2009 shall be deposited into the transportation administration
18 collection fund created under section 810b.
